Dedicated to programming, production, training, documentation and cultural awareness, La Place de la Danse - CDCN Toulouse Occitanie works for the development of today's dances. It is the place in Toulouse where the energies and needs for dance converge, those of artists as well as audiences, professionals and amateurs alike. La Place de la Danse launches a permanent invitation to practice and see, to think and rethink dance.

Professional training EXTENSIONS

Created in 2000, Extensions is the only professional training integrated into a CDCN. Close as possible to the creative work of contemporary choreographers, it contains a programme of around 900 hours geared towards a multiplicity of practice. Before joining La Cité de la Danse in 2028, the training continues to be deployed in our partner venues in Toulouse and Occitanie. This is an opportunity for future professional dancers to discover several venues and teams in order to experience the mobility inherent in this profession.

Goals Through its pedagogical program, Extensions aims to deepen the technical and artistic qualities of the dancers and prepare them for the profession of choreographic artist in all its diversity. Extensions also prepare them to their professional integration in order to be able to take part in the choreographic creation processes of choreographers established in the region, on a national and international scale.

Content

• Technical classes, workshops & creation time

Approach many unique universes and grasp their demands and freedoms. This course allows you to develop a more global reflection on choreographic writing in order to nourish your artistic singularity

• Choreographic theory & culture

Conferences, shows, meetings with companies in residence or programmed by the CDCN complete the training and are all resources shared with the dancers.

Evaluation method

Although Extensions is not a diploma-granting course, individual interviews punctuate the training to assess its contributions and consider the prospects for professional integration for each of the dancers.



• Training program :

- > 1 or 2 weeks training classes with invited artist
- > Research, composition, improvisation and repertoire workshops
- > Regular public performances
- > Conferences, meetings with the artists and the members of the CDCN, attending several performances, support for information resources
- > Internships in professional dance companies
- > Personal projects and/or collective production in different performance contexts
- > Creation and/or revival of the contemporary repertoire
- > Exchange with other artistic training programs
- > Taking part in the La Place de la Danse's festival organisation

- > Dancers open to all contemporary artistic languages
- > Stage experience required
- > From 22 to 27 years old
- > Good understanding of the French language

Qualifications

- > Strong technical abilities in dance contemporary or other physical practice
- > Excellent choreographic and general culture
- > Interest for any artistic forms (theatre, music, performance, visual arts...)
- > Creativity, open mind and autonomy
- > Taste for experimentation
- > Analytical abilities, intellectual curiosity, commitment
- > Good interpersonal skills, ability to get involved in a group
- > Anatomical and/or somatic knowledge appreciated

Funding

The training program can be funded for the dancers of the E.U. registered with the French employment agency.

A fixed fee of 600 € is requested, regardless the amount of the funding.

Selection procedures

- > Technical evaluation, improvisation, collective workshops and interview
- > Selection at the end of each day
- To prepare for the second round of the audition :
- > A performing self-portrait of 3 minutes maximum
